

## Terms and Conditions for Participation

1. The yearly club registration fees are due upon registration. No refunds will be granted two weeks after practices have begun.
2. United States Swimming (USA Swimming) and/or USA Water Polo registration fees and/or Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) fees for diving are not refundable and must be paid prior to the swimmer/player entering the water.
3. When a swimmer is moved from one group to another, he/she must pay the fee for the highest group in which they participate.
4. Should a swimmer/player/diver decide to discontinue participation in the program with the Lyons Swim Club, any outstanding entry fees are considered an obligation to the Lyons Swim Club, and are payable upon termination of participation.
5. Swim meet entry fees will be billed throughout the course of the swim season and are payable within one week of receipt of bill(s).
6. All swimmers, who are members of the Lyons Swim Club, are required to participate at their highest level of achievement in championship meets (including relays).
7. Each swim family is responsible for a \$50 Hosted Swim Meet fee, billed during the fall winter season.
8. Each family is required to fulfill their volunteer commitment as well as volunteering during our hosted meets/tournaments. If you choose not to volunteer for these meets, you must pay a \$100 opt-out fee per meet. If you do not show up for your volunteer assignment, you are subject to a \$100 fee. No swimmer/player will be allowed to enter the water until this fee is paid.
9. Each swimmer/player/diver and parent or guardian will be asked to agree to a "Code of Conduct" and "Terms and Conditions Agreement" for participation in the Lyons Swim Club. Failure to comply with this code may result in the swimmer/player/diver being asked to leave the team.
10. Any checks returned to the Lyons Swim Club for non-sufficient funds will be subject to a \$25.00 additional handling charge.
11. I understand that as parent/guardian of a swimmer/player/diver, I am not allowed at any time on the deck or in the pool office unless authorized by a coach.
12. I understand that as a parent/guardian of a swimmer/player/diver, I may NOT drop any swimmer/player/diver off on Brainard Avenue, but may enter the parking lot on the North side of the North Campus pool to do so.
